

How to Schedule CodeJIKA as a Subject

So you've decided to run coding in your school. You love the idea of vocational coding that teaches real, usable skills to your learners.

How To Schedule It:

1. First of all, it's easier than you think. (You don't need to know anything about coding.)
2. Secondly, the CodeJIKA team is here to support you.
3. Select one or two high schools with functional PC labs (no internet necessary) and start with three "Intro" lessons.
4. If it's working well, you expand to the 16 lesson course and more classes and then more schools.
5. Teachers may choose to teach it as a non-core subject for a term.

STARTER : 3 Sessions – 2 visits by Subject Matter Expert.

You can also mix: For example: 2 groups on STARTER & 2 groups on LITE.
